PUBLIC HEALTH (HLTH)

Course Load

As you adjust to the quarter system and/or a new environment, we recommend enrolling in 12-16 units, with no more than 3 labs.

You can determine if your course has a lab in the course description. All course descriptions, including prerequisites, can be found in the <u>Cal Poly Catalog</u>.

Course Suggestions

MAJOR

- HLTH 101: Orientation to Public Health (1 unit)
- HLTH 265: Introduction to Community and Public Health (3 units) and
- HLTH 298: Disease Epidemiology (4 units)
 - A permission number (from the department) is needed to take HLTH 265 and 298 concurrently
- HLTH 305: Drugs in Society (4 units)

If a student has credit for both HLTH 265 and HLTH 298:

• HLTH 334: Health Behavior Theory (3 units)

CONCENTRATION

Concentration course selection will depend on your chosen concentration.

ELECTIVES

It's a good idea to consult advisors about your elective choices, especially if you plan to pursue graduate studies. If you have a health career objective, please consult with Pre-Health Advisors in CSM Student Services.

Pay special attention to the footnotes on your curriculum sheet. If an elective course is also a GE, it can be used to fulfill both elective and GE requirements.

SUPPORT

- If needed, BIO 231 and/or BIO 232 (5 units each)
 - o You cannot receive partial transfer credit at Cal Poly for Anatomy or Physiology courses. You must have taken both courses at a community college, or plan to take both courses at Cal Poly.
- If needed, complete any remaining prerequisites for Stat 313*: Applied Experimental Design and Regression Models. Prerequisites are completion of:
 - o Math 118 or score of 8 on the Math Placement Exam (MAPE); and
 - o Stat 217 or 218.
- If needed, complete any of the remaining support courses.

*GE Area B Upper Division will be satisfied through completion of STAT 313



GENERAL EDUCATION

If needed, complete any remaining lower-division GE courses. Otherwise, select an upper-division GE course from area C or D. Some GE courses may also be used to satisfy elective or concentration requirements.

Other Graduation Requirements

GWR

The Graduation Writing Requirement (GWR) must be fulfilled by enrolling in a GWR-certified, upperdivision course OR by completing a GWR Portfolio. For more info on the GWR, visit https://writingandlearning.calpoly.edu/GWR
