Course Suggestions

MAJOR

- STAT 150: Introduction to the Discipline of Statistics
- STAT 313: Applied Experimental Design and Regression Models
 - o The combination of your introductory statistics course (or AP statistics) credit prior to transfer + STAT 313 at Cal Poly will satisfy the STAT 301 + 302 required courses.
- STAT 305: Introduction to Probability and Simulation
- If needed, MATH 241: Calculus IV

ELECTIVES

Consult your advisor about elective choices, especially if you plan to pursue graduate studies.

GENERAL EDUCATION

If needed, complete any remaining lower-division GE courses. Otherwise, select an upper-division GE course.

Other Graduation Requirements

GWR

<u>The Graduation Writing Requirement (GWR)</u> must be fulfilled by enrolling in a <u>GWR-certified course</u> or by completing a <u>GWR Portfolio</u>.
