HONORS PROGRAM FOR JOINT BACHELOR OF SCIENCE AND MASTER OF SCIENCE DEGREE IN ELECTRICAL ENGINEERING

Synopsis

This program provides a means for academically excellent upper-division students to complete MSEE graduate studies while completing BSEE degree requirements.

Program Features

- Simplified application process.
- BS and MS coursework can be taken concurrently.
- Access to graduate student facilities.
- TA appointments (if available).
- Priority registration for EE Department courses.

Students may apply for admission to the Joint BS/MS Honors Program after completion of all EE 300-level courses (or are currently taking the remaining 300-level courses) required by their undergraduate program. Note, **a separate senior project is required**. The unit requirements for either degree are unchanged. The student must elect the MS thesis option.

Minimum Admission Requirements

- Cal Poly cumulative GPA of 3.5 or greater or faculty recommendations with a Cal Poly cumulative GPA of 3.2-3.5
- Completion of all 300-level courses (or the remaining 300-level courses are taken in the quarter of application) and GWR
- Statement of Purpose and Resume
- Completed application package
- Completion of GWR

Undergraduate EE students are invited to attend an information session on the BMS program. Two sessions are held each academic year, during Fall and Spring quarters. At the information sessions, the EE Department's Graduate Coordinator provides more detailed information on the program and encourages program candidates to apply.

The BMS program has three application deadlines in the academic year. They are the 8th week of each quarter. The graduate committee will complete its review and make the recommendation within 1-2 weeks of the deadlines. The common time to apply to the program is between the end of junior year and the enrollment in the EE 460 Senior Project course.


