DEVELOPING THE TWO-YEAR PLAN

The purpose of the Two-Year Plan is to help you design a course sequencing and scheduling plan for a two-year period. All major, support, concentration/minor, GE, and elective courses are plotted by quarters, taking into consideration:

- Your catalog year
- Prerequisites needed
- Typical quarters the courses are offered
- Your concentration/advisor-approved elective area/minor
- Your graduation quarter and year.

Resources Needed

Use the following resources in the development of your plan:

- Your catalog year Curriculum sheet
- The Cal Poly Catalog Course Descriptions (particularly, the Term Typically Offered information)
- Course Planning Form (completed)
- Two year plan form(s)
- If you own or have access to a laptop/smart device, feel free to bring it to the workshop; you'll be able to use the online catalog and available schedules on PASS.

Procedures for Completion

With the resources in hand, do the following:

- 1. Update your curriculum sheet and identify remaining classes.
- Use the catalog, flow chart (for your catalog year and concentration) and Proposed Course Offerings by Quarters sheet to identify any prerequisites to these classes.
- 3. Write major classes, support classes, GE, and concentration courses in the appropriate columns, with unit values and course codes.
- 4. Any course that isn't offered this academic year may not be offered again for some time. Check with the instructor or your academic advisor before entering it into your two-year plan.
