Students are encouraged to enroll in an average of 16 units per quarter.

****One course from each of the following GE areas must be completed: A1, A2, A3, B2, B3, B7 (formerly Area B7), C1, C2, C3, C4, C1-C5 elective, D1, D3, D5, and E (formerly Area D4). B7, C4, and D5 should be taken only after Junior standing is reached (90 units).**

Refer to online catalog for GE course selection, United States Cultural Pluralism (USCP) and Graduation Writing Requirement (GWR).

USCP requirement can be satisfied by some (but not all) courses within GE categories: B7, C3, C4, D1, D3, D5 or E.

¹ If GE courses are used to satisfy Support or Concentration requirements, additional free elective units may be required to satisfy 180 units for degree.
