<b>Phase 1: Proposal Development and Submission</b>	Faculty will be given the approved guidelines as soon as they are adopted by the Senate. Faculty then have until Spring, as outlined in the Cal Poly Curriculum Handbook, to submit proposals for catalog consideration.
<b>Phase 2: Evaluation by GEGB</b>	Normal curricular review will begin with the GEGB and Academic Senate Curriculum Committee.
<b>Phase 3: Course Implementation</b>	Courses will be implemented starting summer of the noted year.

This timeline is specific to **current GE courses** seeking recertification under GE 2020.

Proposals for **brand-new GE courses** (i.e., those never before offered) are not subject to this timeline.

- These proposals will be accepted for consideration once their associated area guidelines have been fully approved.
- New courses may be submitted according to the timetable published by the Registrar’s Office.
