RESOLUTION ON INTEGRITY IN GENERAL EDUCATION TRANSFER SUBSTITUTIONS

| 1 2 3 | WHEREAS, | Cal Poly has established its own version of General Education (GE) within the framework set by CSU Executive Order 1100; and |

| | WHEREAS, | Per arbitrary, but longstanding practice, Cal Poly has permitted the substitution of courses taken off campus after matriculation for credit in conceptually unrelated GE areas; and |
| 10 11 12 13 | WHEREAS, | Examples of this include an <i>Introduction to Cinema</i> course which is allowed to fulfill the philosophy GE area (C2), a course in <i>Ceramics</i> substituted for an english C1 course, and a course in <i>Infant & Toddler Development</i> counted fulfilling the economics D2 requirement; and |
| 14 15 16 | WHEREAS, | The Registrar's Office indicates that 20–30% of Cal Poly students have at least one such incongruous substitution; and |
| 17 18 19 20 | WHEREAS, | Under the current GE substitution practice a person entering Cal Poly as a first-year student could graduate with no literature course in GE, no philosophy course in GE, no economics course in GE, and no social institutions course in GE; and |
| 21 22 23 24 | WHEREAS, | This practice undermines the GE patterns approved by Cal Poly faculty, devalues GE in general, and leads to an inconsistent GE experience for students taking courses at Cal Poly versus those taking courses in transfer; and |
| 25 26 27 | WHEREAS, | Copious opportunities exist for students to take area-congruent GE courses both at Cal Poly and other institutions; therefore be it |
| 28 29 30 | RESOLVED: | That Cal Poly restore conceptual consistency and academic integrity in GE substitutions; and be it further |
| 31 32 33 34 | RESOLVED: | That beginning with students admitted for the first time in Fall 2017, Cal Poly cease the practice of counting courses taken off campus after matriculation for credit in patently unrelated GE areas; and be it further |
| 35 36 37 | RESOLVED: | That this change in practice be shared immediately with the student body via all levels of Cal Poly's academic advising structure; and be it further |
| 38 39 | RESOLVED: | That the GE program and Academic Programs provide the Office of the Registrar a list of conceptually related GE courses to give students guidance and clarity about reasonable |
