Curriculum for Incoming Transfer Students

Illustrated below is the Honors Program transfer student curriculum flowchart and overlay. Features include the following:

- ▶ At least two Honors courses (approved HNRS and HNRC-prefix electives - 5 units minimum) designed to provide engaging and challenging experiences. These are primarily GE courses that may be double-counted toward degree requirements;
- ▶ A leader experience co-curricular requirement;
- ▶ A mentor or learning assistant experience co-curricular requirement;
- ▶ An approved Honors experience track focused on research, international study, or civic engagement and service followed by a 1-unit Honors Track Seminar (HNRS 361);
- ▶ Senior project or an equivalent culminating experience completed within the student's major; and
- ▶ A 1-unit Honors Capstone Seminar (HNRS 461) designed to link a student's senior project with Honors Program learning objectives.
