There were 66,866 total applications in fall 2018, which is an increase of 14.7% from last year.

Fall 2018 first-time freshmen (FTF) applications increased by 6,075 (12.57%) from last year to an all-time high of 54,663.

New transfer (NTR) applications have been up and down over the years. Fall 2018 new transfer applications increased by 2,573 (30.8%) compared to last year.

Fall 2018 new post-baccalaureate/graduate applications decreased by 68 (5.66%) compared to last year.

\*The "Other" group in the graph consists of non-degree-seeking students (e.g., exchange, faculty/staff waiver, transitory, etc.).

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### SELECTION RATES AND YIELD RATES

In fall 2018, Cal Poly selected 30.2% of first-time freshmen applicants. Of these 16,491 selections, 26.7% enrolled, producing an entering FTF class of 4,398 students.

The College of Agriculture Food and Environmental Science had the highest FTF selection rate (44.5%). Architecture and Environmental Design had the highest FTF yield (44.8%). The College of Engineering had the lowest selection rate (22.8%), and the College of Science and Mathematics had the lowest yield (15.6%).


Cal Poly selected 15.9% of fall 2018 transfer applicants. Of the 1,733 new transfer selections, 50% enrolled, resulting in a fall 2018 new transfer class of 867 students.

In fall 2018, Cal Poly enrolled 88 less first-time freshmen students than its target of 4,486, with an enrolled class of 4,398 FTF students.

The fall 2018 FTF class had a new record-high average HS GPA of 4.0. In addition, Cal Poly enrolled 28 National Hispanic Scholars and 20 National Merit<sup>®</sup> Finalists this year.

Cal Poly enrolled 16 more students than its fall 2018 new transfer target.

The College of Engineering enrolled the largest proportion of new transfers, with 24.8% of the 851 new transfers.

The Orfalea College of Business had the highest transfer GPA among the colleges.
