




## Increase in Under-represented Minorities (URM)

## **RETENTION & PERSISTENCE TO GRADUATION**

The one-year retention rate for fall 2018 cohort shows a decrease of 0.1 percentage points as compared to the previous year.

The six-year graduation rate of 83% for fall 2013 cohort is a increase of .80 percentage points from last year.
