This cohort includes students in the Blended B.S./ M.S. degree program (BM S), also known as the 4+1 program. Students in the BMS program are considered graduate students once they submit a Formal Study Plan (graduate) and are accepted into the program. In addition, deceased students and students who left for military service are allowable exclusions; therefore, persistence rates are calculated on a revised cohort that may be slightly lower than the original cohort.
