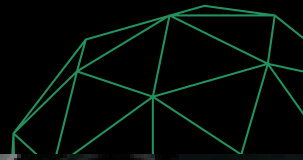


HIVE Series: ox&öl

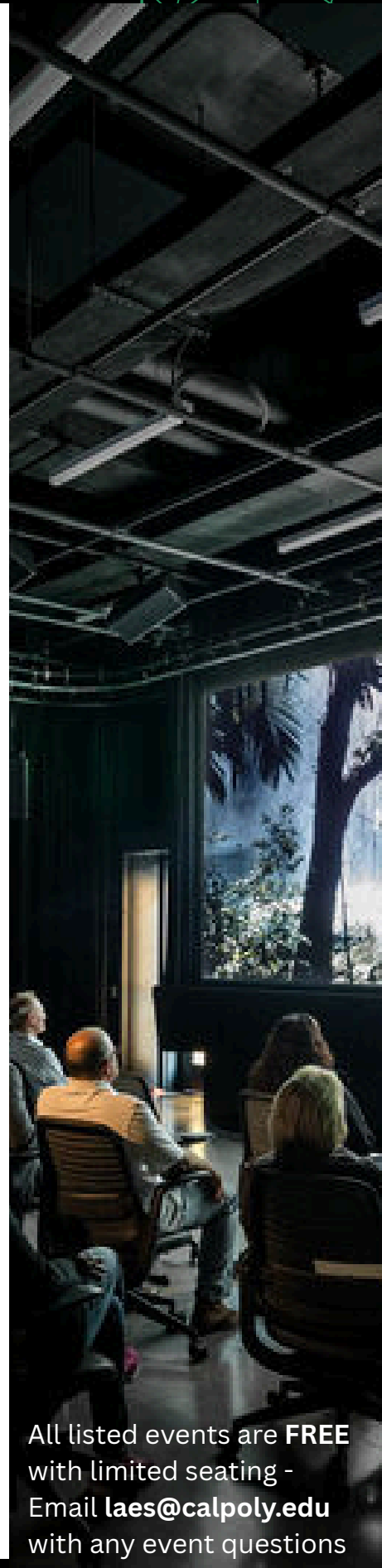

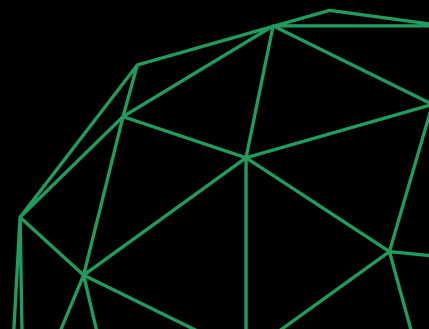
