General CAED Shop Safety Guidelines

1. Know your locations of:

- o Fire extinguishers and pull stations
- o Eye wash/douse showers
- First aid kits
- o Hazardous materials and spill kits
- o Location and use procedures for engineering equipment

2. Laboratory procedures for personal protective equipment shall be followed as noted:

- Eye protection should be worn at all times while in the shop and while constructing your projects.
- o Work gloves should be worn as needed to protect your hands.
- o Ear protection should be worn as needed to protect against loud noises.
- o N95 masks should be worn as needed to protect against small particulates.

3. Appropriate laboratory attire must be worn at all times:

- Sleeved shirt and pants as well as closed-toe shoes required at all times. No loose clothing
- o Long hair must be tied back at all times.
- o It is recommended to remove neckties, bracelets and other loose clothing/jewelry be removed prior to working in the lab.

4. No person shall work alone.

- o At least two people should be working together after hours as well as weekends and holidays.
- 5. No loud radios are allowed.
- 6. No musical headphones/earbuds are allowed while operating power tools/equipment.
- 7. Lab area must be kept clean. Users are responsible for keeping the designated area organized and clean.
