



**Concept Statement:** The proposed landscape design for the Dexter Design Commons aims to create a dynamic, multipurpose, and sustainable space that reflects the uses of the building on the site and the surrounding context. The Dexter building is home to several programs, including Art and Design, Landscape Architecture, and Military Science. This courtyard must serve all of these different users' needs, offering areas for club meetings, studying, eating, art installations, and pin-ups, and relaxation. The design must also emphasize native plantings, stormwater management practices, and permeable paving to promote environmental sustainability and align with the Cal Poly Campus Master Plan and Landscape Master Plan goals.

GENERAL NOTES

1.

All property, easement, and limit lines shall be verified prior to commencing work.
2.

Existing underground utilities and improvements are shown in their approximate locations based upon record information available to the Landscape Architect at the time of preparation of these plans. Locations may not have been verified in the field and no guarantee is made as to the accuracy and completeness of the information shown.
- Survey information of existing conditions provided by California Polytechnic State University.
- Proposed conditions of utility and grading improvements provided by California Polytechnic State University.
3.

The exact location and elevation of utilities shall be determined by the Contractor prior to excavation and demolition. Contractor to provide underground locating service to have the location of existing underground utilities marked. Contractor shall notify all public or private utility owners 48 hours prior to commencement of work adjacent to the utility.
4.

The Contractor shall be responsible to provide ample cover for the protection from damage of existing utilities to remain in place during construction. If live utilities are encountered, not indicated previously, protect the same from damage and immediately notify the Owner and the affected utility provider. Do not proceed until further instructions are received.
5.

The Contractor shall be responsible for preserving any existing survey monuments and any monuments obliterated or damaged during construction will be replaced at the Contractor’s expense.
6.

The Contractor is responsible for maintaining all areas disrupted by demolition or construction work, including planting and irrigation, even when planting and irrigation is remote from area where work is being performed.
7.

Contractor shall not willfully proceed with construction as designed when it is obvious that unknown obstructions, area discrepancies and/or grade differences exist that may not have been known during Such conditions shall be immediately brought to the attention of the Owner’s representative.
8.

All construction activities shall be performed in such a manner as to comply with the standards established by the Air Quality Maintenance District for airborne particulate (dust).
9.

Contractor shall remove from the site all debris and unsuitable material generated by the Contractor’s operations and dispose of all material in compliance with applicable codes and regulations. Construction site shall be maintained at all times so that no obstruction, construction equipment or construction process causes potential harm or danger to the public or the construction site.
10.

Contractor is responsible for replacement or repair to any existing structures, site features or materials indicated to remain.
11.

All site work shall be in conformance with local administrative code and Americans with Disabilities Act accessibility guidelines (ADAAG). Construction shall conform to all applicable codes and regulations. Unless otherwise specified, specific references to codes, regulations, standards, manufacturers’ instructions, or requirements of regulatory agencies, when used to specify requirements for materials of design elements shall mean the latest edition of each in effect at the date of submission of bids, or the date of the change of order or field orders, as applicable.
12.

Report discrepancies in drawings to the Landscape Architect for clarifications and adjustments before work. Any deviations or changes in these drawings without written acceptance of the Landscape Architect shall absolve the Landscape Architect of any and all responsibility of said deviation and change.
13.

Written dimensions take precedence over scaled dimensions.
- 13.1.

Obtain acceptance of horizontal alignment of elements in the field from California Polytechnic State University's authorized representative prior to installation.
14.

Dimensions indicated on plans for horizontal control are accurate if measured on a level Measure horizontal control dimensions on a level line, not parallel with ground slope.
16.

See Civil drawings for site demolition plans and proposed grading and utilities.

SOIL PREPARATION NOTES

1.

Contractor shall verify all site conditions and utility locations prior to commencement of planting and soil preparation work.
2.

Refer to Engineer’s Plans and Specifications for Bioretention Soil Specifications, extents, and depths.
3.

A Soil Management Report (Title 23, Chapter 2.7, Section 492.5), is recommended for native soil areas within the project limit of work. The report shall contain, at a minimum:

-

Soil texture; N-P-K and minor trace elements

Infiltration rate determined by laboratory test or soil texture infiltration rate table

pH

-

Total soluble salts

-

Sodium hazard

-

Percent organic matter

Recommendations based on an organic approach to soil
4.

Native topsoil is to be maintained on site and amended per approved soils report. Contractor is responsible for testing and amending topsoil to required depth as part of this contract. Contractor shall provide testing of existing topsoil and soil amendments products.
5.

Clear all planting areas to a depth of 6-inches of stones 2-inches in diameter and larger, weeds, debris, and other extraneous materials prior to soil preparation work. If buried hardscape materials such as asphalt, concrete, or gravel are encountered in areas of new planting, remove and replace with native soil or clean fill.
6.

Amend and cultivate the top 18-inches of soil in landscape areas for planting soil, outside of bioretention area as identified in Note 1. Maximum soil compaction in planting areas shall be 85%. See drawings for extents.

PLANT NOTES

1.

Grades shall be approved by the Owner’s authorized representative prior to installation of plant materials. Perform fine grading in all planting areas and coordinate finish grade to allow mulch depth of 3-inches.
2.

Contractor to submit for all Plant Material:

-

Color photographs of representative plants of each specified species from each nursery or other place of growth.

-

Quantities and sizes of each plant material type at each nursery or other place of growth and contact person and information for each nursery or other place of growth.

-

Nursery-grown plants should conform to American Standards for Nursery Stock under climatic conditions similar to those of the project.

-

Tagging of plant material at the nursery or place of growth does not affect the right of the Owner’s authorized representative to reject plant material at the site, if damage or unacceptable conditions are found that were not detected at the nursery or place of growth or in submitted photographs.
4.

Plant delivery and handling:

-

Do not deliver disease-infected plant materials to the site.

-

Plants should show no evidence of a pot-bound condition.

-

Furnish standard products in manufacturer’s standard containers bearing original labels showing quantity, analysis, genus/species and name of grower.

-

Keep plants that cannot be planted immediately upon delivery in shaded areas that are well-protected from wind and damage, and water well.

-

Do not lift or handle plants by tops, stems, or trunks, and do not bind or handle plants with wire or rope, at any time.
5.

Dimensions for the placement and layout of plant materials shown on drawings are approximate. Layout of plant materials shall be approved by the Owner’s authorized representative prior to installation of plant materials, e.g. when shrubs have been spotted for planting, but before planting holes have been excavated.
6.

Warranty Period:

-

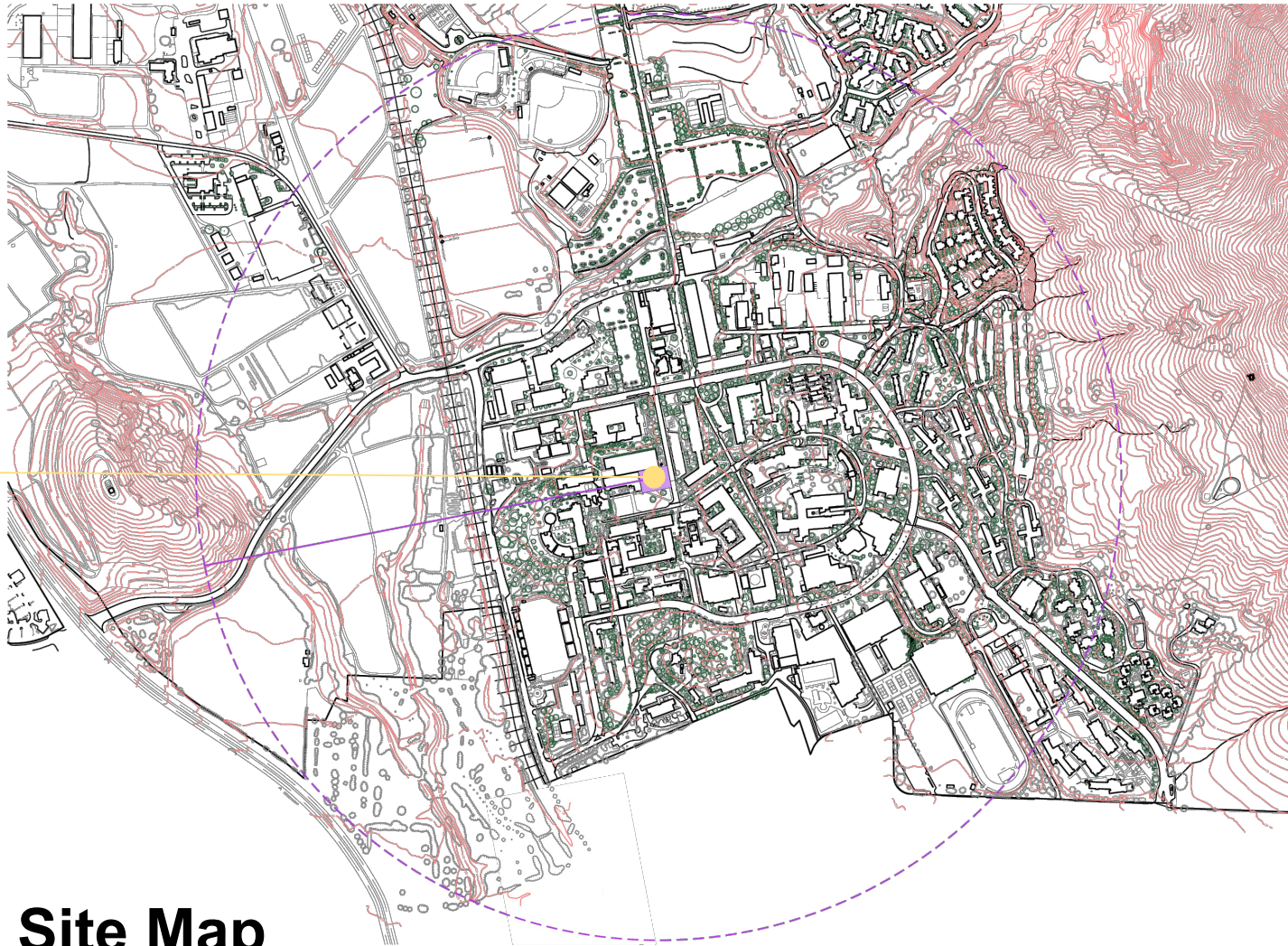
Warrant that all plant materials are true to species and variety and replace incorrect materials.

-

Plants shall be in vigorous, thriving condition, free of dead or dying branches and branch tips, with foliage of normal density, size, and color. Repair or replace all plant materials that are not in said condition and plants that are dead, as determined by Owner’s authorized representative, with the same kind and size as originally planted.
7.

After planting is complete, furnish and spread mulch over entire planted area in conformance with drawings, at a minimum depth of 3-inches for both organic and inorganic mulch types.
