\*Non-resident students pay fees (listed above) PLUS \$264 per unit non-resident tuition and an annual opportunity fee of \$8,304.

\*International students pay the non-resident tuition and opportunity fee, plus an additional fee of \$900 and \$1,586 for mandatory health insurance.

Registration fees are estimated and subject to state budget approval.

Housing and meal costs are estimated.

Books and supply costs may vary depending on the courses students take each quarter.

Federal Loan borrowers have estimated loan fees added to the cost of attendance.
