

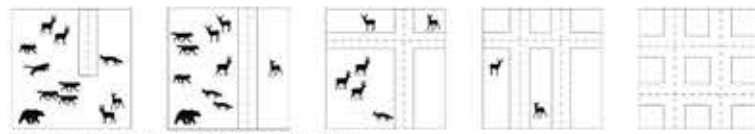
# WILDLIFE CROSSING PROPOSAL
