8:50 - 9:00 a.m. Welcome from External Relations: Yukie Murphy & Kanani Makekau

- Yukie welcomed members and reflected on the university's growth and ongoing construction projects, including the new Student Success Center and additional housing. She emphasized the university's transition from quarters to semesters as a significant milestone.
- Kanani and Stanley introduced themselves and facilitated introductions of all PAC members. Members shared their hometowns, students' majors, and experiences with Cal Poly, highlighting the council's diverse representation.

**9:00 – 9:30 a.m. Welcome Address:** Vice President for Strategic Enrollment Management and Student Affairs, Terrance Harris

- VP Harris introduced himself and shared his background as a Cal Poly alumnus and legacy member of the campus community.
- He provided updates on the Strategic Enrollment Management and Student Affairs (SEMSA) merge, designed to streamline the student lifecycle from recruitment through graduation.
- Key campus initiatives discussed:
  - Student Success Center: Opening planned for 2027; will serve as a hub for student engagement, career services, and co-curricular collaboration.
  - Major Housing Project: Expansion of student housing along Perimeter Road to meet enrollment growth.

- Year-Round Operations Initiative: Aims to expand summer residential enrollment and increase total capacity toward serving 30,000 students annually by 2028.
- Diversity and Inclusion: Continued commitment to representing California's demographic diversity through equity-driven student success and retention strategies.
- VP Harris fielded questions on direct admissions, student engagement, and mental health. Members emphasized the need for inclusive, accessible engagement spaces to reduce student isolation.

## 9:30 - 10:00 a.m. Associated Students Incorporated (ASI) Report: ASI President Marc Cabeliza

- Marc shared ASI's role as a nonprofit auxiliary supporting student life, funded by student fees.
- Current priorities:
  - Expanding student visibility and representation across colleges.
  - Implementing a grocery shuttle pilot program to improve food access.
  - Launching a medical vending machine for after-hours wellness support.
  - Advocating for telehealth and mental health access beyond 8-5 hours.
  - Continuing large-scale engagement programs like "Buck the Stigma" and intramural events.
- Marc also emphasized partnerships with Student Affairs and university leadership to ensure student voices inform key initiatives.

#### 10:00 - 10:45 a.m. Maritime Integration: Dr. Beya Makekau & Josh Machamher

Dr. Makekau & Josh provided updates on the integration of the
Cal Poly Maritime Academy with Cal Poly SLO. The integration
aims to preserve the maritime institution's unique culture while
aligning academic programs, student services, and governance
structures under the Cal Poly name.
