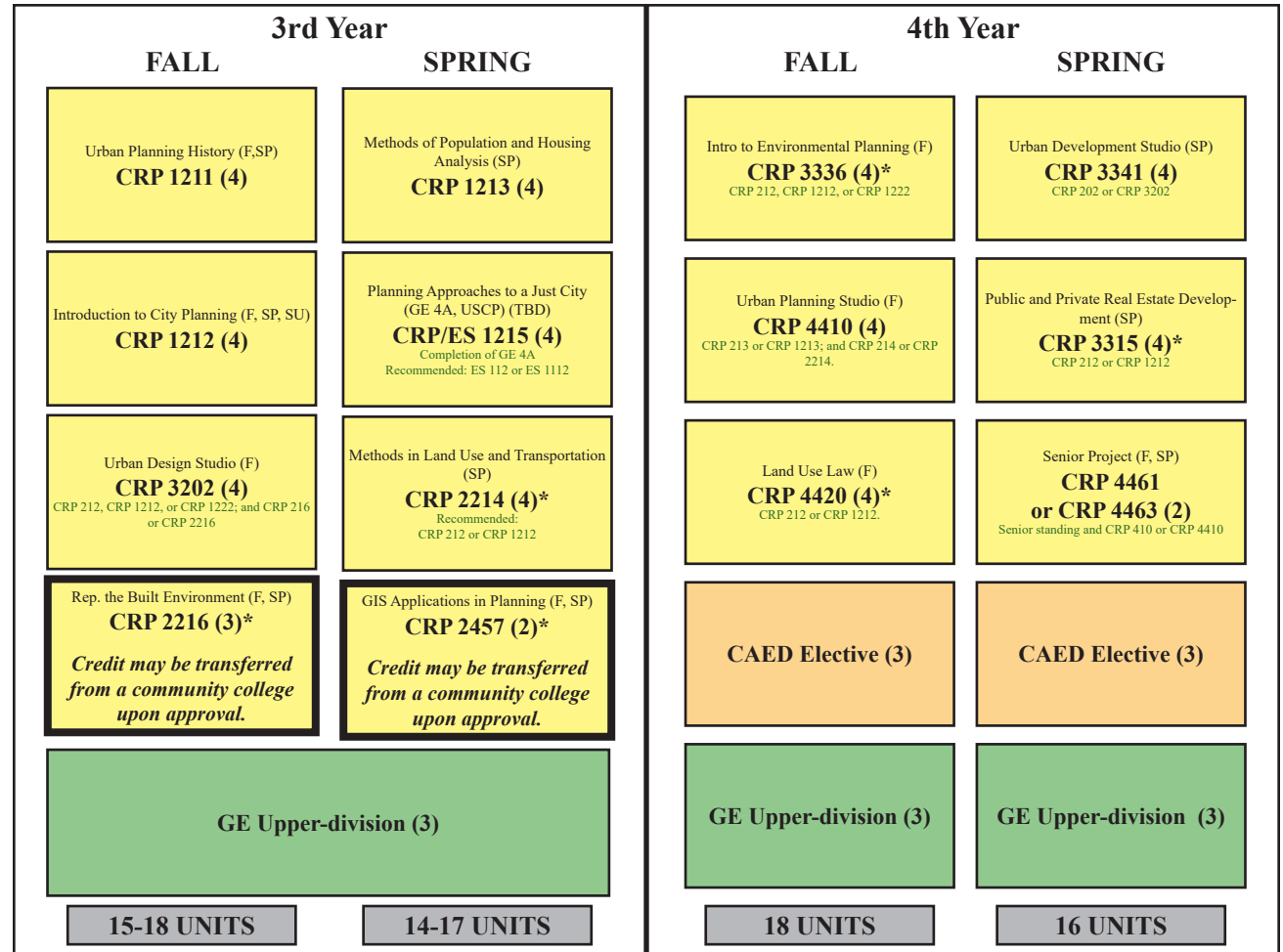

This flowchart assumes completion of Required AND Desired Courses.

The major requires 20 Free Elective units. Courses used for Free Electives may need to be at the 3000-4000 level to ensure completion of the requirement minimum of 40 units of upper-division. Additionally, if a GE course is used to satisfy a Major/Support requirement, additional units of Free Electives may be needed to complete the total units for the degree.
