

Accelerated MCRP Program

Cal Poly Architecture and Landscape Architecture students may pursue an accelerated route to a graduate professional degree through enrollment in Master of City & Regional Planning (MCRP) courses during their fourth and fifth year of undergraduate study, plus an additional year of graduate study after completion of their undergraduate degree.

Admission

Prior to beginning the MCRP courses in their last two undergraduate years, students will request a pre-acceptance evaluation from the MCRP Graduate Program Coordinator. Prior to this evaluation, students must have completed CRP 212 Introduction to Urban Planning with a "B" grade or better. As a co-requisite to the program, students must complete CRP 314 Planning Theory with a "B" grade or better during their undergraduate years (this can be before or after the pre-acceptance evaluation).

Students will begin the admissions process during their last year of undergraduate study and will be subject to the standard MCRP admission procedures and requirements. Students who complete the first year of the Accelerated MCRP are not guaranteed admission to the MCRP program.

Course Requirements

- As an undergraduate student, you must complete CRP 212 and CRP 314 (see above).
- As an undergraduate student, you must complete 12 MCRP graduate units not used toward undergraduate degree requirements (i.e., no double-counting). The courses taken to complete the 12 units must be courses required for the MCRP Program.
- As a graduate student in the MCRP program, you must complete 12 PBAC units through Credit by Examination.
- As a graduate student in the MCRP program, you must complete 48 PBAC units in residence by taking core and elective courses as required for the MCRP degree.

Planning Internship

A planning internship is required. Students are required to complete an internship. If a student completes an internship during the undergraduate degree that has a professional planning dimension (by approval of the MCRP coordinator), their MCRP internship will be waived.
