

## **Alternative Transportation Committee**

### **Purpose**

The purpose of the Alternative Transportation Committee is to assist Cal Poly in identifying and prioritizing recommended opportunities to improve pedestrian, bicycling, transit and other non-single occupancy vehicle commute modes to overcome barriers to the use by members of the campus community. This committee has been developed to comply with the requirements of the [CSU Transportation and Parking Policy](#)<sup>1</sup>

### **Membership**

Membership for faculty and staff shall be for a period of two (2) years, staggered to ensure continuity. Students shall be appointed annually. Recommendations for membership from campus constituencies should consider the backgrounds of the persons selected to ensure that students with disabilities and students from disadvantaged communities are represented.

The members of the Alternative Transportation Committee will be determined by the Senior Vice President of Administration and Finance (A&F) and indefinite unless specifically noted and will consist of:

1. Two (2) students; recommended by the Senior Vice President of (A&F) , and/or Associated Students, Inc.; 1-year term.
2. Two (2) faculty; recommended by the Academic Senate; 2-year term.
3. Two (2) staff representatives
4. Transportation Manager/TDM Coordinator; Chairperson; Ex Officio; indefinite term.
5. Transportation & Parking Director; Ex Officio; indefinite term.
6. Sustainability Coordinator; Ex Officio; indefinite term.
7. One (1) representative from the Chancellor's Office, designated by the Chancellor's Office, non-voting member; indefinite term.

Other faculty, staff, and students may be requested to participate on an as needed basis.

### **Meetings**

The Committee will meet quarterly during the academic year or as needed to fulfill the committee's function. Other meetings will be at the discretion of the Committee Chairperson. Attendance will be reviewed periodically throughout the year.
