Coordinating Committee on AIDS & HIV Infection (CCAH)

Functions

Established in response to the <u>CSU AIDS Policy and Guidelines</u> (AAES 88-27), the Cal Poly Coordinating Committee on AIDS and HIV Infection is advisory to the President, reporting via the Vice President for Student Affairs. The committee is charged with planning and coordinating a comprehensive educational program; developing and reviewing administrative procedures related to AIDS and HIV Infection; and monitoring and ensuring compliance with campus, system, state, and federal policies.

Membership

The CCAH will be a universitywide standing committee composed of faculty, staff, student, Corporation, and community members. Faculty, staff, and Corporation appointees will serve staggered two-year terms. Student and community representatives will serve one-year terms. Members may be reappointed as necessary.

The chair of the CCAH will be the Chief of the Medical Staff, Cal Poly Health Center. In addition to the chair, committee membership will include:

The Health Educator

One representative from Academic Affairs, nominated by the Provost

One representative from Administration and Finance, nominated by the Vice President for Administration and Finance

One representative from Facilities Services, nominated by the Vice President for Administration and Finance One representative from Student Affairs, nominated by the Vice President for Student Affairs

One representative each from Disability Resource Center, Student Academic Services, Student Life and Leadership, Recreational Sports, and Residential Life and Education, nominated by the Vice President for Student Affairs

Two community members (e.g., from the Director, County Health Department; Community AIDS Support Network) nominated by the Vice President of Student Affairs

One representative from Library Administration, nominated by the Vice Provost for Information Services/CIO One representative from ASI, nominated by the ASI President

One student-at-large, nominated by the Chief of the Medical Staff, Cal Poly Health Center (e.g., Student Health Advisory Group)

One representative from the Human Resources Department, nominated by the Executive Director of Human Resources

One representative from the Academic Senate, nominated by the Executive Committee of the Academic Senate

Two representatives from the Cal Poly Corporation, one of which is to be from the Campus Dining division, nominated by the Executive Director of the Cal Poly Corporation

Staff_Support

Committee support will be provided by appropriate staff from the Health Center, Counseling Center, Human Resources, Environmental Health and Safety, or other areas as appropriate.

Meetings

Meetings will be held once each quarter during Fall, Winter, and Spring quarters, or at the discretion of the chair.
