The following courses are prereqs for Cal Poly's MSTEP program. Where indicated, Cal Poly Child Development Majors and Minors are waived from the prereq.

- EDUC 207: Children's Learning and Development in Educational Settings *Waived*. Satisfied by completion of PSY/CD256, CD305, & CD306
- EDUC 300\*: Historical, Philosophical, and Social Foundations of Public Education
- EDUC 427: Theories, Methods, and Assessment of First and Second Language Acquisition in Schools
- EDUC 428: Foundations of K-8 Literacy Teaching and Learning in Schools with Diverse Populations

\*CD majors enrolled in an internship at an elementary school while concurrently enrolled in EDUC300, satisfy the school observation requirement for EDUC300.

## **Additional Course Information**

The following courses are not prerequisites for entering the MSTEP program but are required before earning a credential:

- KINE 181: First Aid/CPR NOTE that the CPR card has to valid when applying for your credential after completing the MSTEP program. Most CPR cards are good for 2 years. This means students would need to be sure they will complete the MSTEP program within two years of taking this course. Otherwise, wait to get CPR certified later.
- KINE 443: Health Education for Teachers
