The Founding Generation Summer Internship program provides funding to qualified students who wish to conduct infancy research in the lab of a researcher for an 8-week summer period (20 hrs per week). To qualify for support, <u>students</u> must contact a participating ICIS faculty member (outside their home institution) to request sponsorship. Students may initiate contact with someone whose research they already know or by reviewing a description of potential hosts posted on the ICIS website (to be posted mid-February). Sponsoring faculty must agree to the following:

- To mentor the student (remotely or in person for 2021) for an 8-week period;
- Ensure a stimulating research experience;
- Define a project and associated tasks that will be ready for the student to begin immediately and complete during the summer internship;
- Provide one-on-one contact with the student during weekly standing meetings;
- Identify individuals who will train the student and regularly monitor student progress;
- Be an active member of ICIS (non-ICIS members may join at any time if they wish to sponsor a student).
