Fall 2010

Expected Academic Progress (EAP)

- Effective for those who are admitted as of Fall 2010
- Requires students to make a predetermined level of progress towards their declared major each academic year
- Progress is measured using their degree audit and reflected in a report



Fall 2010

EAP Report

- Produced by using point-in-time data that is extracted from PS after the census date of each quarter
- Distributed by the Office of the Registrar to colleges after the census date and before the start of registration for the next quarter in any given term
- The information is also reflected in Poly Profile




Change of Major

- Effective for Students Admitted Fall 2010 and after
- How Students, Advisors, and Dept Chairs/Heads navigate the new workflow:
 - Where to start
 - Where to go next
 - Where it ends
- Once the portal workflow is available, change of major forms will be obsolete
- Fall 2010 is the transitional quarter

ICMA¹ workflow (in development)




¹ICMA – Individualized (student specific) Change of Major Agreement

AP/DQ

- Fall 2010
 - New students – new policy/code
 - Continuing Students – existing policy/codes
- Communication plan for Winter Quarter
- Winter 2011
 - All students – new policy/codes



Fall 2010

AP/DQ – New Codes

Subject to Disqualification

- SDQ1 – anytime the CP cum or HE cum GPA < 2.0
- SDQ2 – on AP for 2 consecutive quarters
- SDQ3 – on AP for 4 non-consecutive quarters

Disqualification

- DSQ1 – on AP 3 consecutive quarters
- DSQ2 – on AP 3 or more non-consecutive quarters and CP cum or HE cum GPA < 2.0



Fall 2010

Prerequisite Project...how's it going?

- Winter 2011: Phase I implementation; courses with no changes to prerequisites
- Winter 2011: Registration
 - Some coding issues – quickly resolved
 - GE areas – further refinements made
 - Math course prerequisites
 - Curricular issues unearthed
- Summer 2011: Phase II implementation; courses who have introduced changes to their prerequisites

On-line Grade Changes – What, really????

- Up to 7th week of term following original grade (online)
- Up to 1 year following original grade (paper form)
- All other grade changes (paper form)
- Come to open forum on 12/3/10 for a closer look

The Office of the Registrar is dedicated to providing administrative support and service in accordance with the Family Education Rights and Privacy Act ([FERPA](#)), to the university's faculty, staff, and students.

The Office of the Registrar is composed of three functional areas referred to as Records, Evaluations, and Curriculum and Scheduling.

Records is responsible for student records. This includes registration, enrollment verification, grades, transcripts and other related services.

Evaluations is primarily responsible for validating academic degree progress which includes the graduation evaluation process. Evaluations can advise students about major requirements, degree posting, graduation evaluations and other degree related issues.

Curriculum and Scheduling is responsible for the production of the institutional catalog, the procedural/mechanical aspects of the curriculum process, the scheduling of academic classes, and management of the campus master calendar.
