Dear Student:

The faculty and staff at Cal Poly recognize that despite the pandemic slowing down, life is anything but "normal" for most of us. We want you to know that the Cal Poly community is here to support you. While we understand that everyone is experiencing unique challenges during this time, the university is required by virtue of the <u>academic probation and</u> <u>disqualification policy</u> to notify students of their academic standing at the end of each term.

This email serves as official notification that you have been placed on Academic Disqualification status because your Cal Poly cumulative GPA (CPSLO GPA) and/or higher education GPA (Higher Ed GPA) fell below the academic progress level GPA limits based on your academic progress level (see detailed chart below the signature).

To remain active in your program and return for next quarter, you will need to appeal for reinstatement. We highly encourage you to follow the directions below to appeal:

- Submit your appeal by completing this <u>Academic Disqualification Status Appeal Form</u>
 - o All appeals are due by 5:00 p.m. on Wednesday, December 21, 2022

Your college will review your appeal and, if approved, will provide ongoing support. You should be notified of this decision by January 3, 2023.

If you do not appeal or if your appeal is not approved, you will be dismissed from the university and will no longer be an active Cal Poly student.

- Dismissed students will be dropped from winter quarter classes.
- Students who have been dismissed may apply for readmission in the future.
