ADVANCED PLACEMENT (AP®) CREDIT for exams taken in 2019

USEFUL INFORMATION:

Our AP school code is 4038. See the College Board site: <https://apscore.collegeboard.org/scores/score-reporting> for details on Score Reporting Services.

We prefer electronic score reports, and scores from multiple years need to be combined into one file.

AP exams are passed by earning a score of 3, 4 or 5, earn a Credit (CR) grade and are not calculated in the GPA. A maximum of nine (9) quarter units are earned; fewer when exam content is duplicated (see below).

When credit and units are earned for a specific course(s), the excess unit(s) count as electives. Cal Poly GE Areas and numbers are listed and may be different from CSU GE Areas and numbers.

Degree credit applied may vary depending on: major, GE requirements, catalog, exam year, AP score and CSU policy. Credit extension is reviewed annually and adjusted if the exam content and/or Cal Poly courses change.

⚠ To determine credit for combined exams only, use the AP matrix for the year of the last exam taken. e.g.: if exams are taken in 2018 and 2019, 2019 exam credit will be used.

♦ If credit is granted for one of these courses, refer to the current CalPoly catalog before enrolling in any other class listed: it may repeat content and thus not receive degree applicable credit.
