We have completed the evaluation of your transfer credits. Thank you so much for your patience during this manual process! We in the Office of the Registrar know how vital it is to see your transfer credits and test scores accurately reflected in your evaluation, thus we updated your records as quickly as we could to ensure you have all the information you need to plan your fall courses.

You can view your evaluation using the Degree Progress Report (also known as the DPR), Cal Poly's automated degree audit. The Degree Progress Report is an accurate reflection of all your transfer coursework and test credits for which we have received final grades and scores. The report will show you how your previous coursework and test scores satisfy major, support, and General Education requirements.
