Degree Planner 🤌

egree Planner is an excellent tool to use to plan your degree requirements for future terms. However, during your first term at Cal Poly, your Degree Planner may not yet match the recommended coursework suggestions for your major. Your Degree Planner will become increasingly accurate after one to two terms.



Degree Progress Report (DPR) 🔗

Vou should plan to check your Degree Progress Report immediately before and immediately after registering for classes each term. Regularly checking your Degree Progress Report will help to ensure your classes are fulfilling the degree requirements you expect.



Term Planning Calendar 🔗

The Planning Calendar is published each term and has key dates and deadlines. Each Planning Calendar will tell you when registration opens, when classes begin, what the withdrawal deadlines are, and when grades are finalized for the term (just to name a few).



Student Center 🔗

Vour Student Center is a hub for a variety of important tools and information in your portal. You can find your schedule, any outstanding fees, holds*, registration information, and multiple other helpful resources.

As a first-time student, if you log in and are unable to see some of the features in your Student Center for fall term, your student record may still be undergoing setup. Please allow 24 hours, then log back in. If you are still unable to see Student Center features, contact Admissions to inquire about your status. They will be able to guide you to the appropriate resource for assistance.

*For any holds you see on your account, reach out to the department or office that placed that hold.



Schedule Builder 🔗

chedule Builder is the tool you will use each term to plan your class schedule. Once you have planned coursework in Degree Planner, you can pull those planned courses directly into Schedule Builder to generate different class schedule options.

As a first-time student, if you log in and are unable to see Schedule Builder for fall term, your student record may still be undergoing setup. Please allow 24 hours, then log back in. If you are still unable to see fall term classes in Schedule Builder, contact <u>Admissions</u> to inquire about your status. They will be able to guide you to the appropriate resource for assistance.
