Dear Cal Poly Retired Faculty and Staff,

As the president of the Retired Faculty and Staff Association (RFSA), I'm pleased to announce that the minimum level to establish an endowment has been amended to \$12,500 for current and retired faculty and staff of Cal Poly (CRFSCP) through the end of the Power of Doing campaign. An endowment is an excellent way to support Cal Poly's future. Many current and retired faculty and staff, including myself, have created endowments that are already supporting the Learn by Doing experience of our students.

The following are guidelines to establish an endowment:

1. The minimum contribution must be \$12,500. This must come entirely from CRFSCP. Participants are encouraged to seek and include additional outside support.
2. The endowment may be funded over a five-year period to reach the minimum contribution.
3. A single endowment may be created by multiple CRFSCP members.
4. The endowment creators may determine a name and use of the endowment.
