Instructional Student Assistant (ISA) Training

Facilitator and Leader training is offered one to three times each academic year for programs affiliated with Student Academic Services. These programs include Supplemental Workshops in Math and Science, Study Session, and Summer Institute. The training occurs during a single four-hour period and is led by peers and professional staff.

Learning Outcomes

As a result of training, facilitators and group leaders will be able to:

- Ensure safety in the work environment
- Respond appropriately to distressed students
- Enhance group dynamics
- Understand their role as group facilitator
- Resolve group problems
- Utilize group games to enhance student engagement and learning
- Demonstrate sensitivity to student diversity

Assessment Results

After completing ISA training, participants reported the following levels of confidence in their ability to facilitate a group.
