

Identity Finder Data Decision Workflow

The results of the search are displayed in the **Results View** and, along with the **Preview Pane** and the **Properties Pane**, provide all of the relevant information about the result including the full path to its location, the type and value of the result, a preview of that result in context, and many other details.

If Level 1 data is discovered, a decision needs to be made to delete the file if you no longer need it, or remove the Level 1 content within the file and save the cleaned file.

I. If the scan result identified a file that does not contain Level 1 data

- A. Tell Identity Finder to Ignore
 - i. Windows – [Ignore](#)

II. If the scan result identified a file that contains Level 1 data

- I. If the **file is not needed**, securely delete it using the shred feature
 - i. Windows - [Shredding sensitive information](#)
 - ii. Mac – [Shredding sensitive information](#)
- II. If the **file is something you REALLY need**, is it useful without the Level 1 data element(s)?
 - i. If yes, open file and delete the Level 1 content and save the cleaned file.
 - i. You can use the **scrub** feature in Identity Finder to do this for you.
 - 1. Windows – [Scrub or redact information](#)
 - 2. Mac - [Scrub or redact information](#)
 - ii. If no, work with Information Security Office or IT staff to secure file.
