PRELIMINARY ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES CREDENTIAL

Qualified candidates can earn the Preliminary Administrative Services Credential concurrently with the master's degree. This practical program prepares candidates to assume positions of leadership in California's K-12 school system. Students will gain real-world experience by participating in three quarters of fieldwork experiences in addition to classroom learning.
