## Program Description

Candidates who successfully complete the Multiple Subject program will be recommended for a California Preliminary Multiple Subject Teaching Credential that is English Language Learner Authorized. This credential allows you to teach multiple subjects in California elementary classrooms. However, Multiple Subject credential holders may teach any K-8 grade level as long as their assignment consists of teaching in a self-contained classroom.

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## HOW TO APPLY - Multiple Subject Program

1. Create a login on Cal State Apply at https://www2.calstate.edu/apply
2. Select the Program to which you wish to apply. The Multiple Subject Program is a Graduate Teaching Credential program. You can only apply to one program at Cal Poly at a time, but you can change the program at any time before submitting you application.
3. Complete the Four Quadrants of the application:

$\rightarrow$ Upload of Early Field Experience evidence
$\rightarrow$ Upload of clear tuberculosis test

$\rightarrow$ List of any related or required courses currently in progress or planned (courses not included on your transcript)
