# **Program Description**

Candidates who complete the Single Subject Teacher Education Preparation Program (SSTEP) may be recommended for a California Preliminary Single Subject Teaching Credential that is English Language Learner Authorized in one of the following nine specialization areas: agriculture, biology, chemistry, English, geosciences, mathematics, physics, social sciences and World Languages in Spanish or French.

Cal Poly's Single Subject Program provides California with dedicated teachers who are competent, caring and creative. Graduates of the program are particularly well prepared to:

- → Engage and support a wide range of students in learning
- → Create learning environments that are inclusive, culturally responsive, healthy and safe
- Organize subject matter and learning sequences to engage students in creativity, inquiry and problem solving
- → Use, collect and analyze student assessment data from multiple measures to plan and strengthen teaching and learning
- → Use technology to achieve educational goals for students
- → Be reflective practitioners, recognize personal biases, identify areas for growth and contribute to the field of education

HOW TO APPLY - Single Subject Program

- 1. Create a login on Cal State Apply at https://www2.calstate.edu/apply
- 2. Select the Program to which you wish to apply. The Single Subject Program is a Graduate Teaching Credential program. You can only apply to one program at Cal Poly at a time, but you can change the program at any time before submitting your application.
- 3. Complete the Four Quadrants of the application:

### 1. Personal Information

### INCLUDES

- → Legal and preferred name
- Legal sex and gender orientation
- Current contact information and permanent address
- → Citizenship/residency information
- → Race/ethnicity selections
- → Language proficiency
- Current military and academic status
- → History of academic infractions
- → Parent education level

## 2. Academic History

#### **INCLUDES**

- → History of all colleges attended (include community college, summer and distance courses)
- → List of any related or required courses currently in progress or planned (courses not included on your transcript)
- → GPAs
- Standardized test scores for ACT or SAT

# 3. Supporting Information

## INCLUDES

- Information about employment, internship and volunteer experiences
- → Upload of Basic Skills Requirement documentation (or qualifying ACT/SAT)
- → Upload of content area CSET examination scores
- Upload of Certificate of Clearance
- Upload of Early Field Experience evidence
- → Upload of clear tuberculosis test

## 4. Program Materials

#### NCLUDE

- → Cover letter, submitted under supplemental materials
- → Upload of all unofficial transcripts
- → Contact information for two evaluators who will provide letters of recommendation
- → Answers and assurances to supplemental questions
