This decision will directly impact our SABE students, alumni, friends and family. The SABE program stands in solidarity with all undocumented students and their families. We pledge to continue to advocate for their rights and protection at local and national levels.

This year, the SABE program is partnering with the Central Coast Coalition for Undocumented Student Success (CCC-USS), a local organization of educators dedicated to educational equity for undocumented students <http://www.ccc-uss.org/> Through this partnership, SABE teacher candidates will research existing programs and propose plans to address unmet needs for our K-12 undocumented community.
