



Jim Birch joined MBARI in April 2007 and is currently the Director of the SURF Center (Sensors: Underwater Research of the Future), overseeing a group of scientists and engineers engaged in all aspects of ESP design, development, and field deployment. Jim received his B.S. from the University of North Carolina, Chapel Hill, and his M.S. and Ph.D. from the University of Michigan. While a research scientist at the University of California, Berkeley, he worked on the fluid dynamics of insect flight using a scaled robotic

insect model immersed in two tons of mineral oil. He continued honing his instrument design experience at Lawrence Livermore National Laboratory, working on various biodetection technologies and point-of-care diagnostic devices for biomedicine before coming to MBARI.
