

Prevention Measures Include:

500 gallon "water buffalo" or larger on site.

Water supply to be always available onsite during Fire Watch.

Recommend a 5,000 gallon supply.

Water supply to have pump and hose that can reach entire operation.

Have a fire watch continue for 2 hours after everything on site is out cold to the touch.

Do not attempt to fight a fire larger then 20' x 20' Immediately call 911 in case of any fire.

If Red Flag is declared for the unit, operations must cease



Note: This is a recommended guideline, this is not a rule or regulation. Always keep in mind that you or your organization is responsible for any fire caused by your operations whether it follows this guideline or not.

Air Curtain Burner/Carbonator Challenges

Limitations to onsite biomass regetation processing

- 1. A large, "flat" staging area is required, with a buffer of removed vegetation and a water source nearby.
- 2. ACB/carbonator requires a heavy equipment operator + field staff to buck/load logs into the unit while it's running.
- 3. Cool down periods required before you can leave a site.
- 4. Ideal climate conditions are sometimes hard to predict for ACB/carbonator operation.
- 5. Winter conditions are ideal for processing, but unpaved roads limit access.
- 6. Potential energy/emissions goes "up in smoke" during both of these processing options. No (or minimal) opportunity for cost recovery.



- 4. Burn Day Status: Fires are only allowed on permissive burn days. Check the MBARD Website at http://www.mbard.org/ after 4:00 p.m. the day prior to determine burn day status. The burn day status link is found at the top right of the website page.
- 5. Burn Hour Restrictions: No ignitions shall commence after 5:00 p.m. and the hours of burning must comply with burn hours allowed by the local fire agency.
- For field crop burning (a crop other than fruits or vegetables that is grown for agricultural purposes such as cotton and hay), no ignitions shall commence before 10:00 a.m. or after 5:00 p.m. of any day.
- 6. For all burns, all burnt materials shall be extinguished (cold to the touch) by sunset.
- 7. Smoke Production: Piled material must be arranged to provide adequate aeration to allow the material to burn with a minimum of smoke.


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


