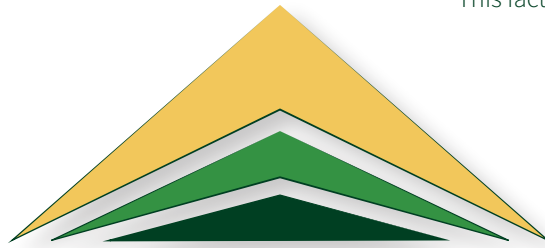

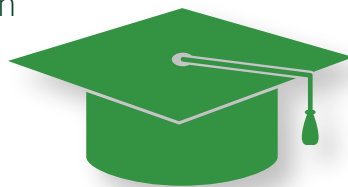

853 NEW TRANSFER STUDENTS IN 2021: Who Are They?

29% admitted transfer students were First Generation; Compared to 11% for first-time freshmen



*CSU defines as any college for either parent

95% are California residents

37% of transfer students identify as underrepresented minority; Compared to 22.5% for first-time freshmen

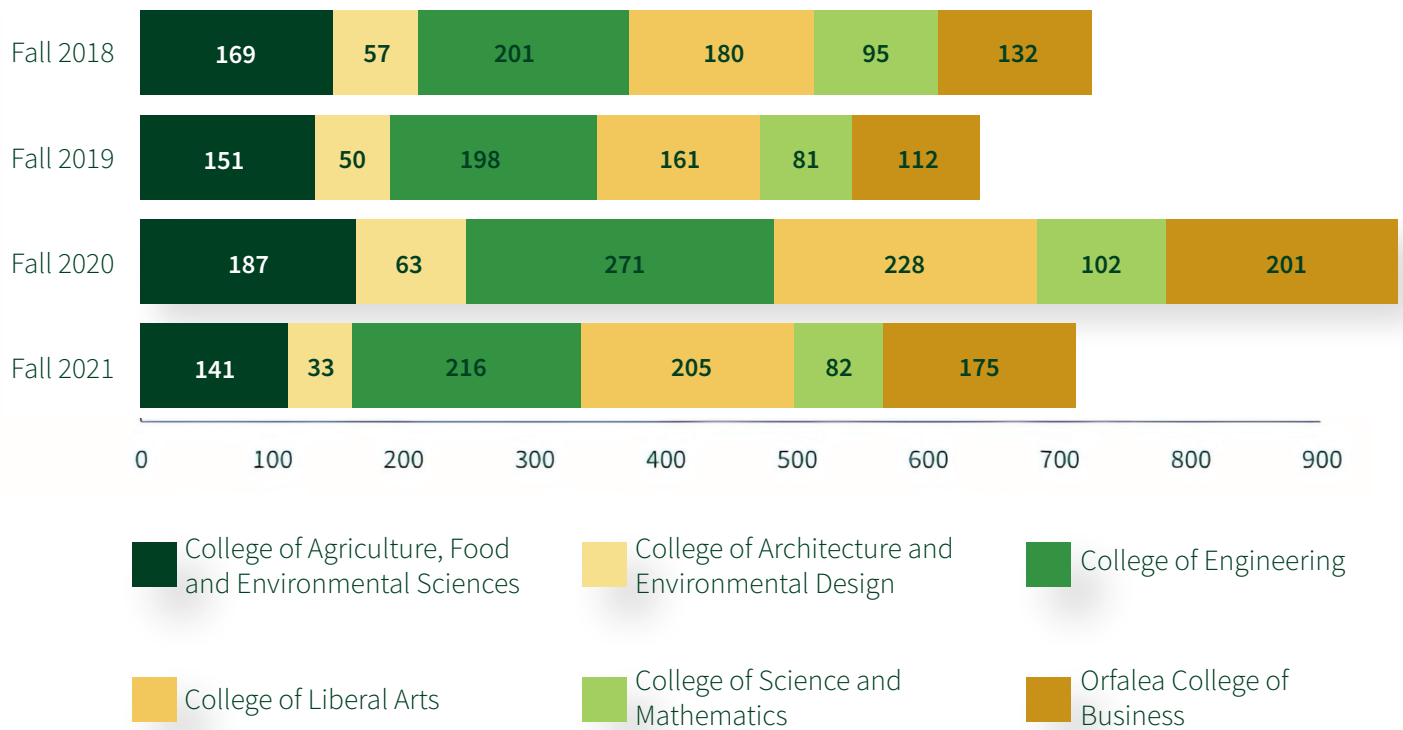

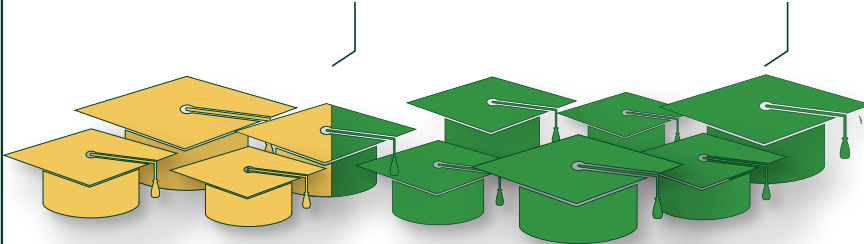
CSU GRADUATION INITIATIVE 2025:

California legislature's strong overall efforts to increase college retention and graduation rates in the state.

CURRENT TRANSFER GRADUATION RATES

Incoming Class of 2018
2 year graduation rate – 39.4%

Incoming Class of 2016
4 year graduation rate – 89.8%



CLOSING THE GAP

Graduation gap for Pell students:

Incoming class of 2019

2 year – gap is 8.9%

Incoming class of 2017

4 year – gap is 5.9%

Graduation gap for URM students:

Incoming class of 2019

2 year – gap is 1.3%

Incoming class of 2017

4 year – gap is 7%

Graduation gap for 1st Gen students:

Incoming class of 2019

2 year – gap is 8.9%

Incoming class of 2017

4 year – gap is 4.7%
