Benefits

All positions include:

Requirements & Wages

RESIDENT DIRECTOR (1)

\$15.50 per hour at 40 hours per week June 21 – July 24

Minimum Qualifications:

- Bachelor's degree before Summer Academy start date of June 21, 2020
- Minimum one-year housing experience (preferably with Cal Poly University Housing)

Responsibilities:

- Work closely with UB Program Coordinator
- Oversee all resident staff – meetings, communication, team-work, programming activities
- Directly supervise a team of 13 students; participate in programming activities
- Dine with participants

NIGHT SUPERVISOR (1)

\$15.50 per hour at 40 hours per week June 21 – July 24

Minimum Qualifications:

- Bachelor's degree before Summer Academy start date of June 21, 2020
- Minimum one-year housing experience (preferably with Cal Poly University Housing)

Responsibilities:

- Duty hours 10 pm – 8 am, Monday night – Friday morning
- Hall checks 2 - 4 times per night
- Attend weekly resident staff meetings

RESIDENT ADVISOR (3)

\$13.50 per hour at 40 hours per week June 21 – July 24

Minimum Qualifications:

- Minimum one-year housing experience with Cal Poly University Housing

- Directly supervise a team of 13 students; participate in programming activities
