• Ultimately, continue to build a culture of evidence wherein we work together to take responsibility for establishing, reviewing, and demonstrating student learning and institutional and program level improvement

These objectives are woven into appropriate theme areas.

Approaches for the Two Reviews

Our proposed approaches are described in the following table. Within each theme, the key study questions were created to lead the campus in a formative study process to reach the outcomes shown in the Capacity & Preparatory and Educational Effectiveness columns. Some study questions are geared toward the achievement of Capacity & Preparatory outcomes that are required for reaching our ultimate Educational Effectiveness outcomes.
