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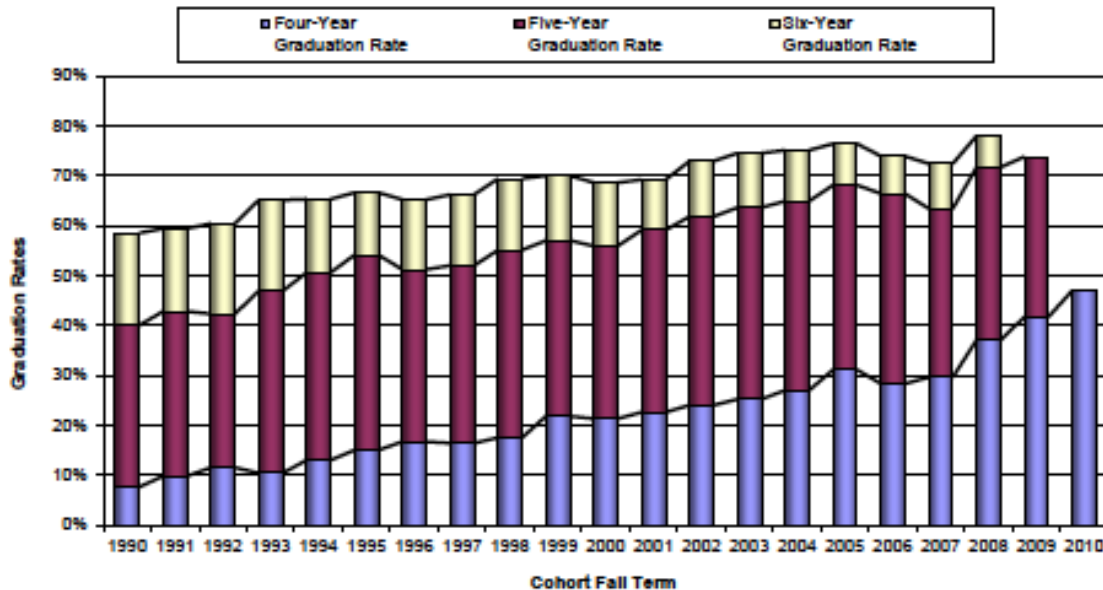

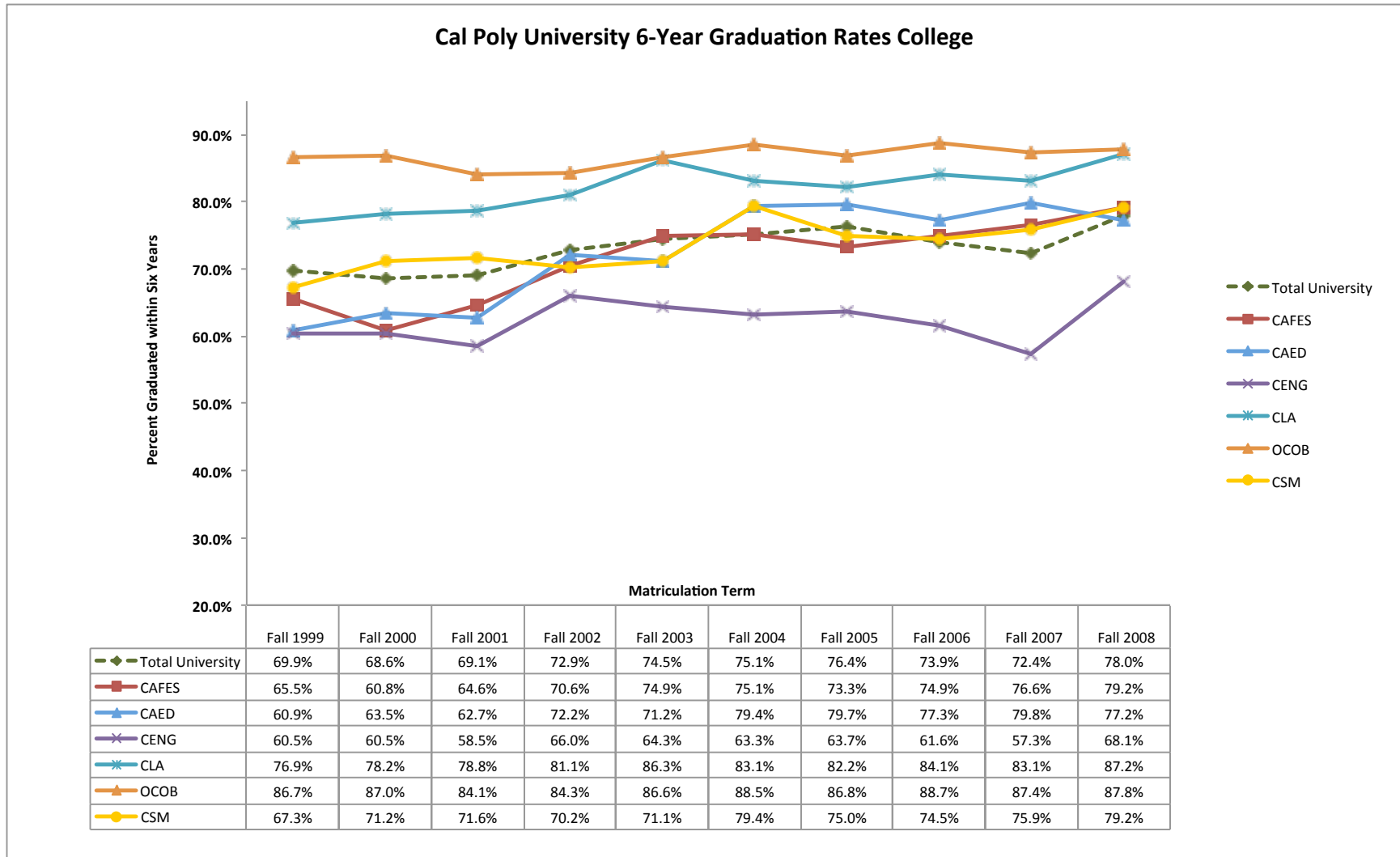

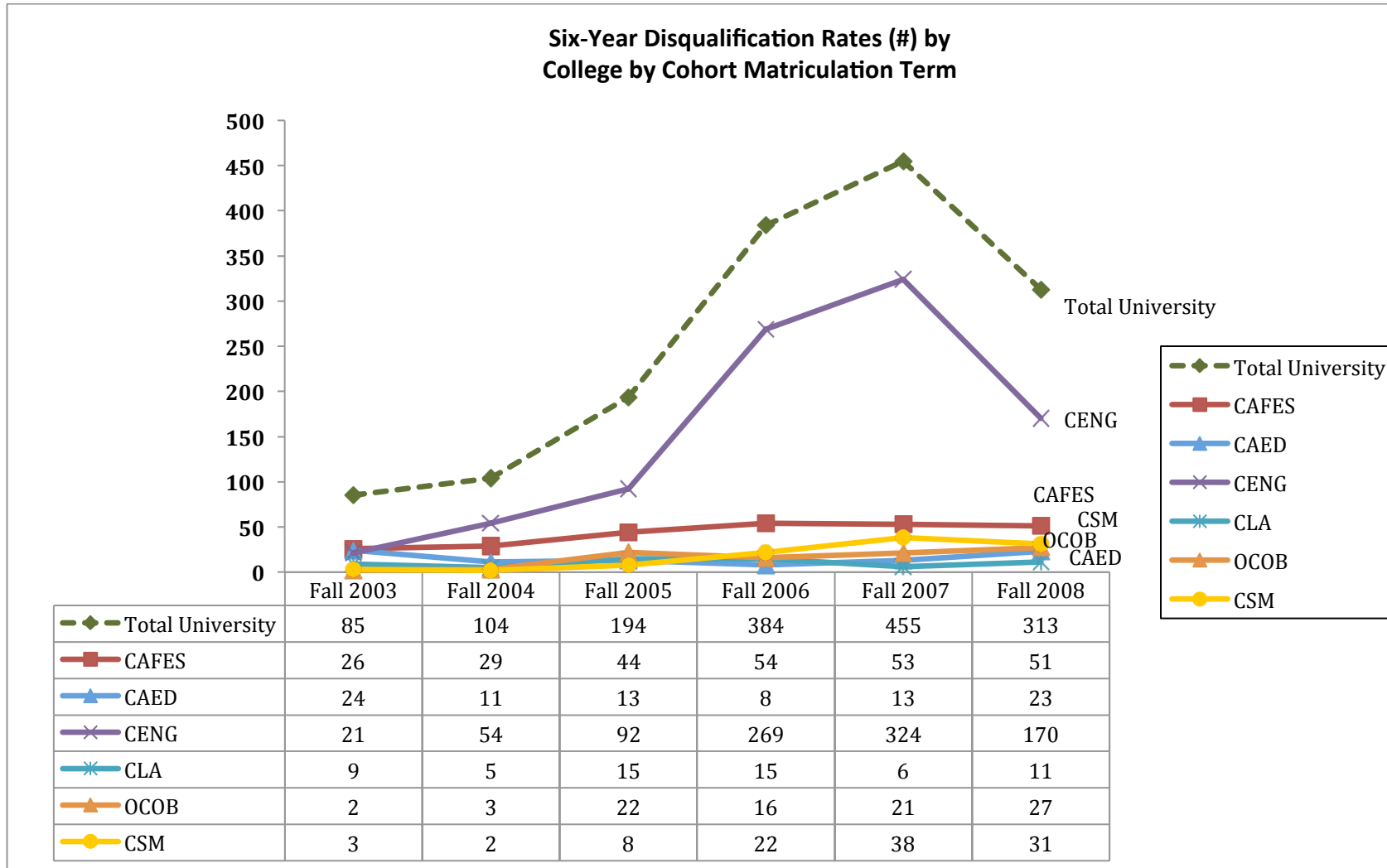

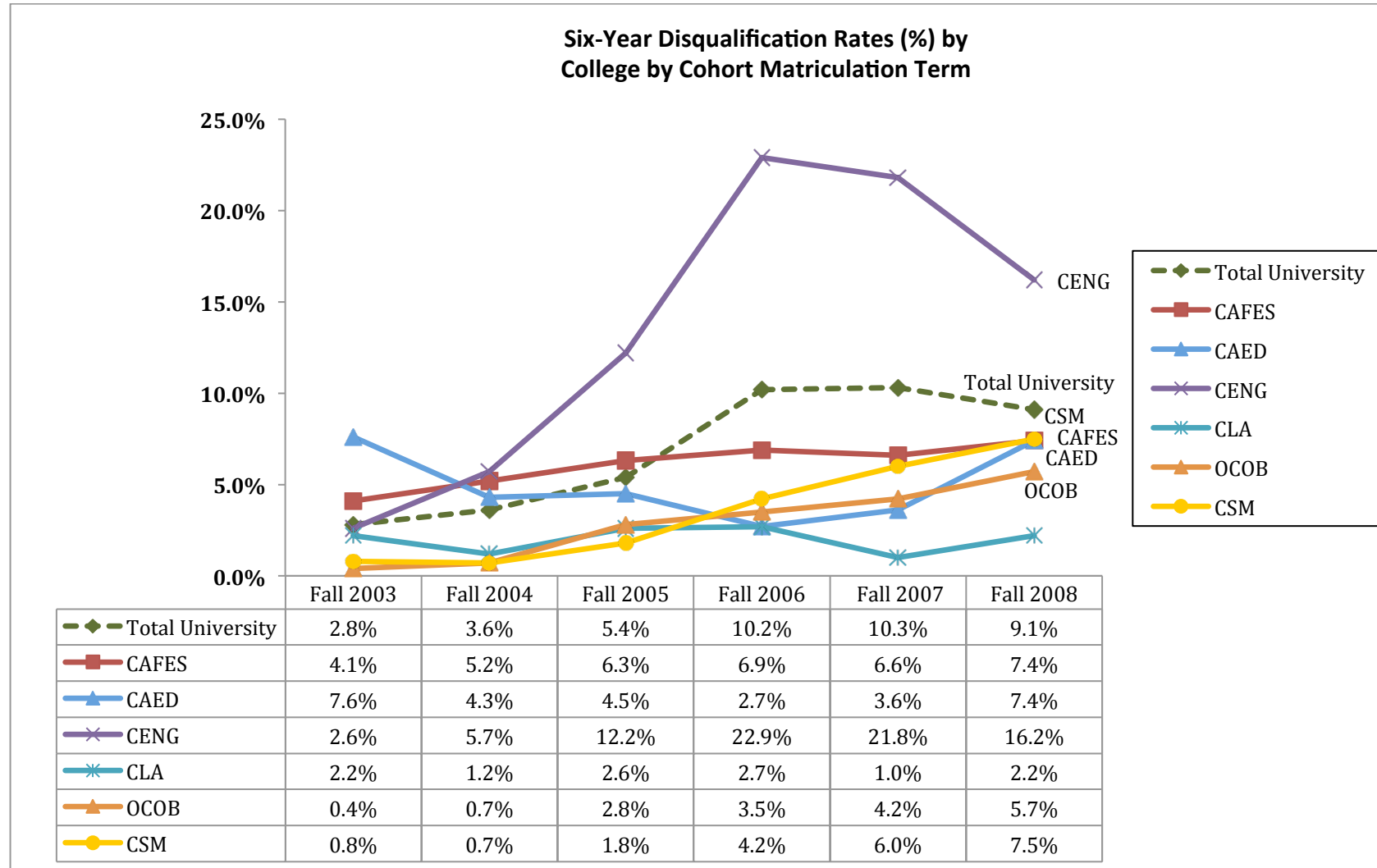

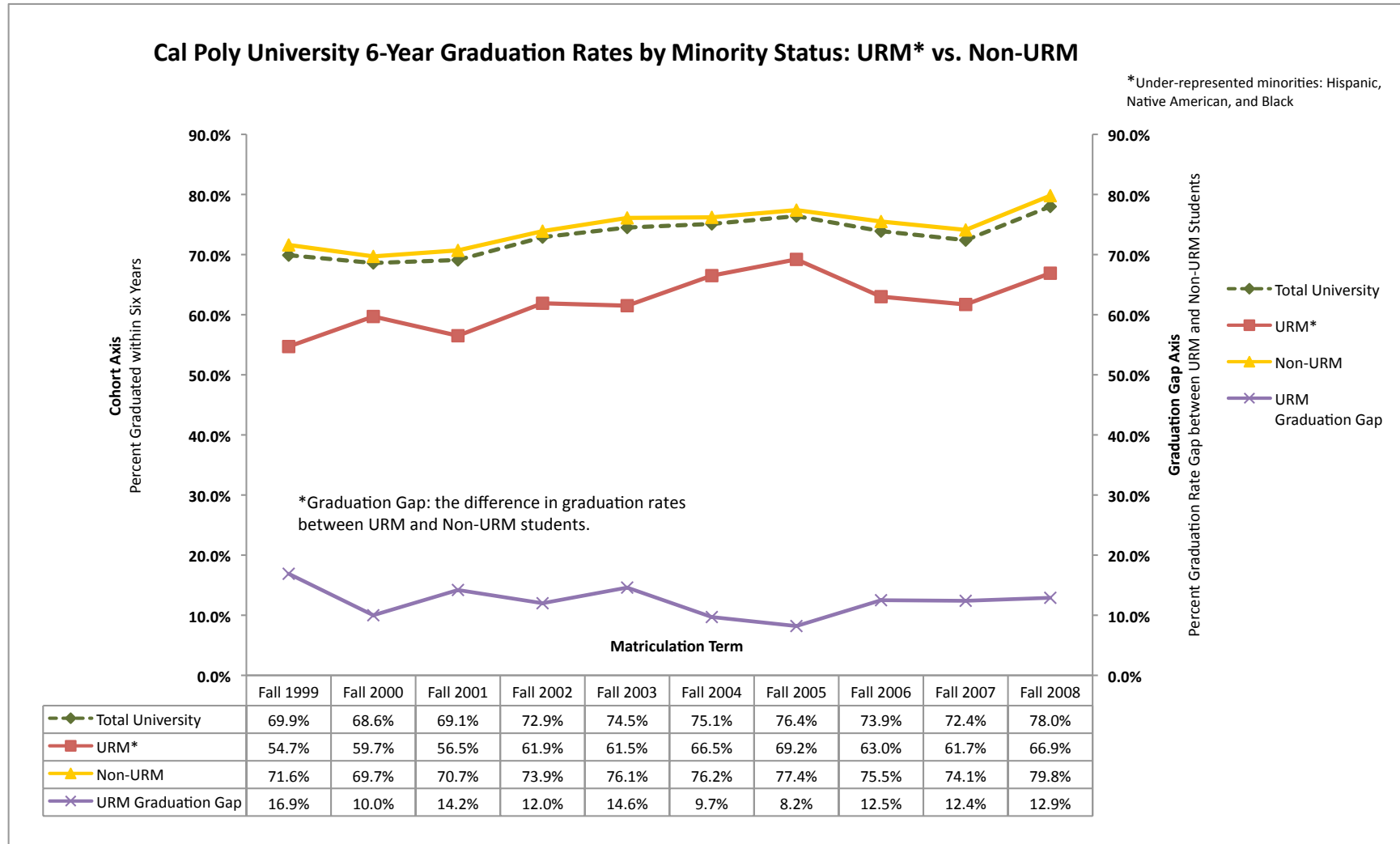
### Appendix A.24. Cal Poly Six-Year Disqualification Rates by College

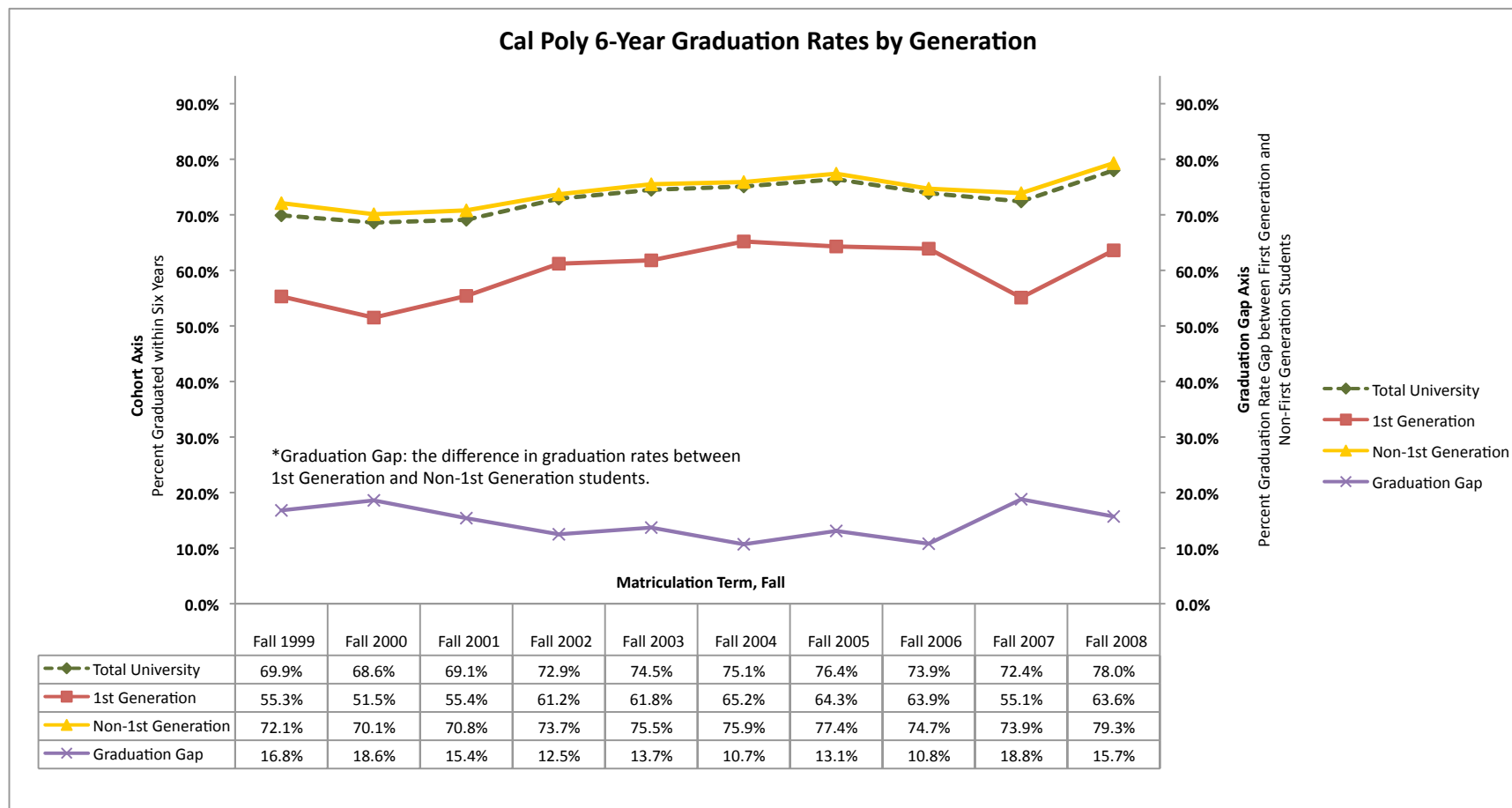


## Appendix A.25. Cal Poly Six-Year Graduation Rates by URM Status



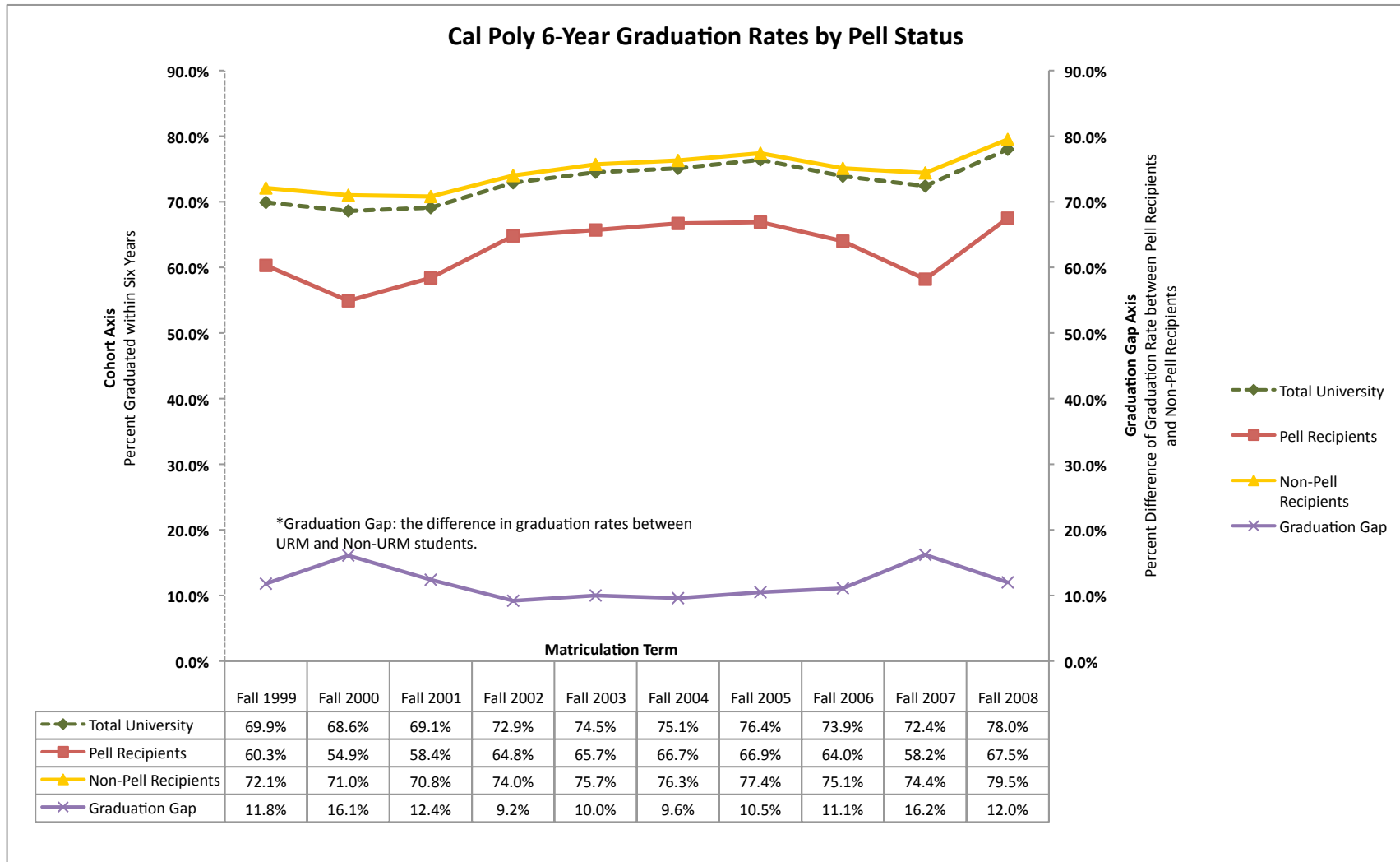

## Appendix A.26. Cal Poly Six-Year Graduation Rates by First Generation Status



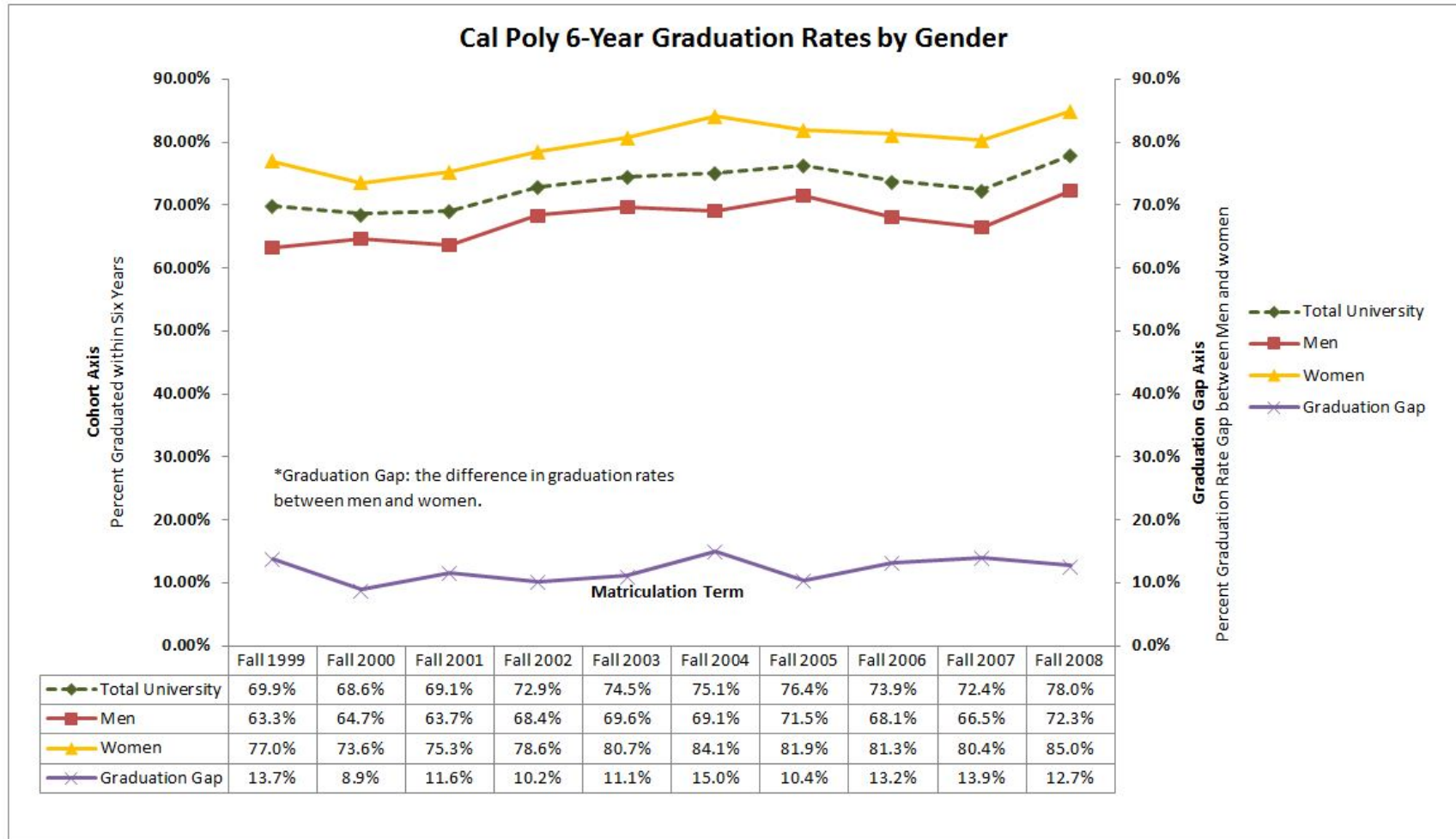

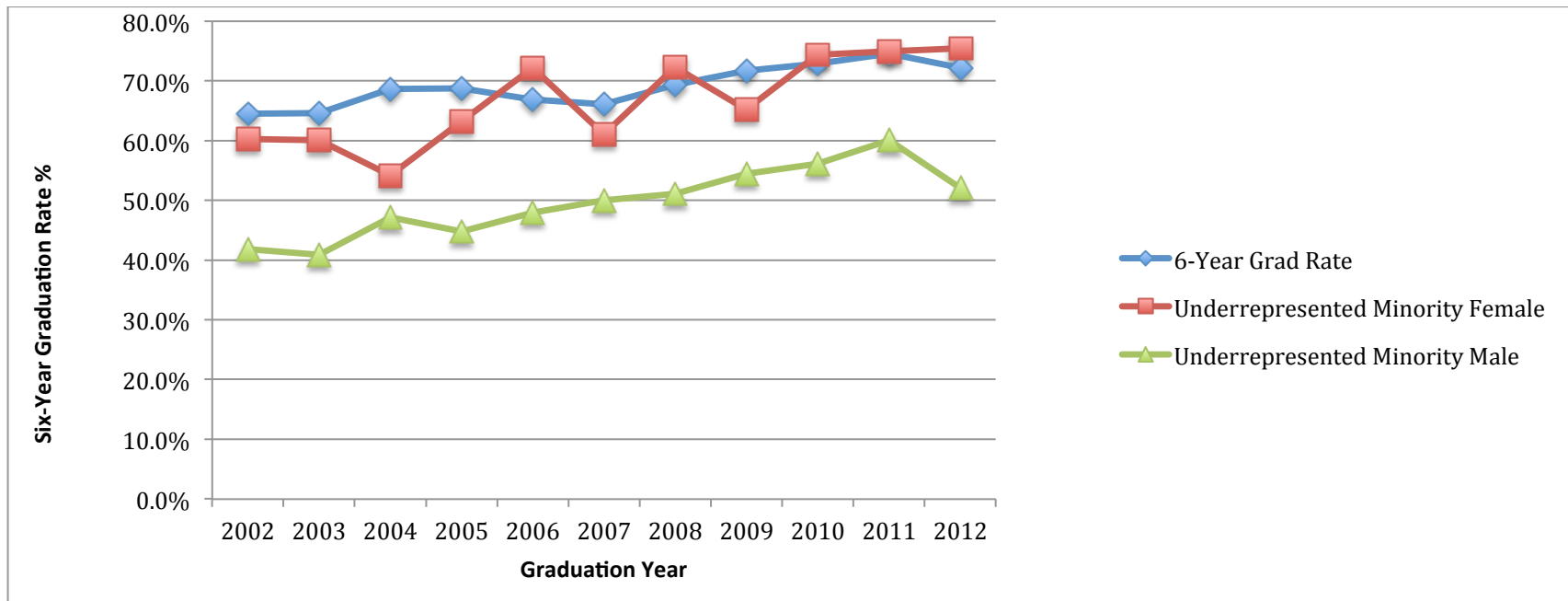
## Appendix A.28. Six-Year Graduation Rates by Gender

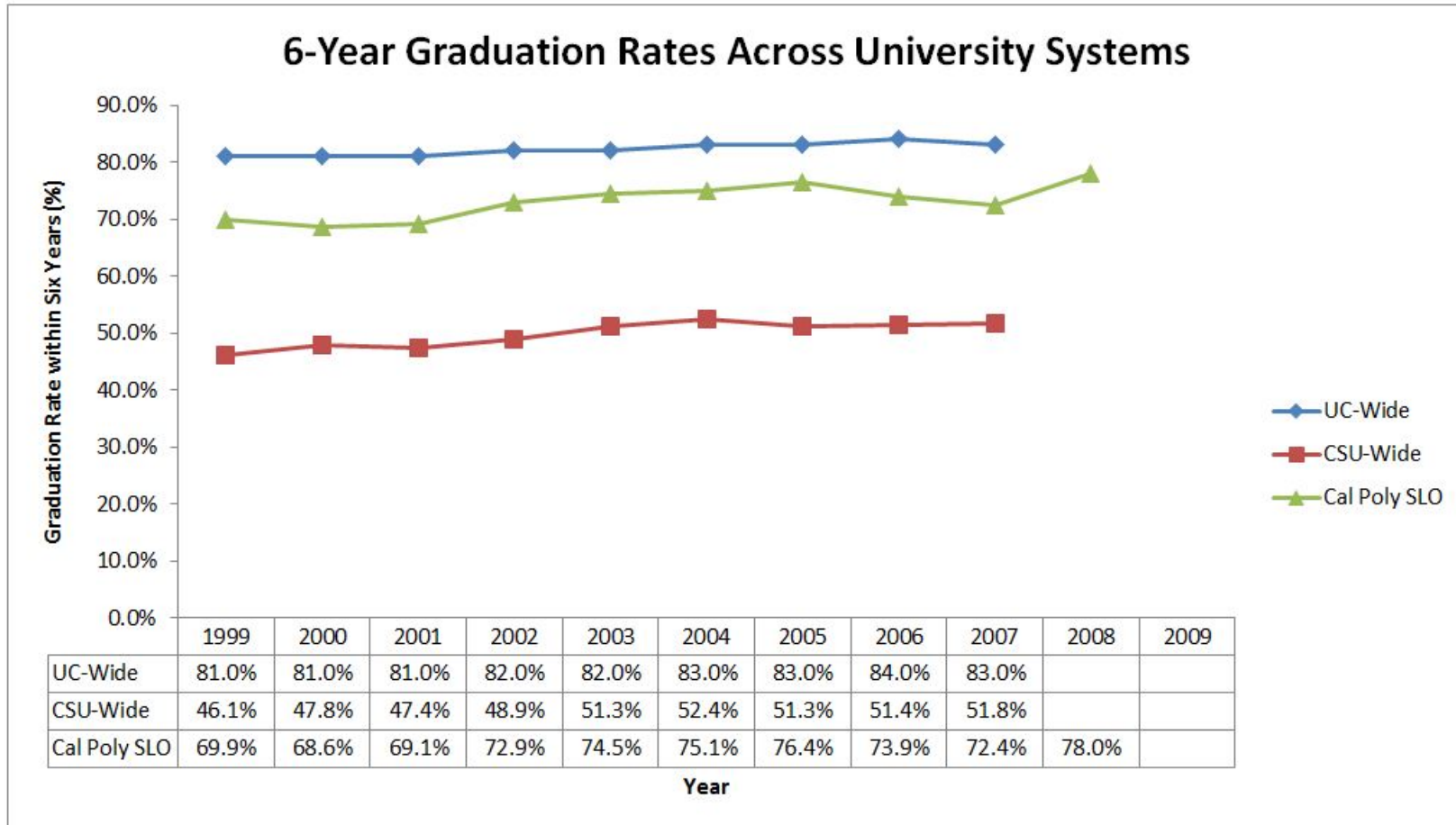
